### **Ekphrastic Poetry Lecture, with Clarence Wolfshohl**

- In conjunction with our upcoming Mimicking the Masters exhibit, Art House offers this free lecture. As far back as classical Greece, poets have written about artwork. Homer describes the beautifully wrought Shield of Achilles in The Iliad. In the canon of English literature are such memorable works as John Keats's "Ode on a Grecian Urn" and Robert Browning's "My Last Duchess." Ekphrasis still attracts poets and, in fact, has become a popular genre for contemporary poets. Clarence Wolfshohl, professor emeritus of English at William Woods University and volunteer at the Art House, will discuss ekphrastic poetry—its history and characteristics—by presenting poems with the paintings that inspired them.

### **Workshop: Painting Plein Air with Pastels, with Lorraine McFarland**
