



## 2019 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

During Callaway Plein Air, artists may paint anywhere in Callaway County on public land or on private property with owner permission. Below is a list of group painting venues and events. For a detailed list of suggested locations and detailed directions to all locations, refer to the map and key. Numbers in parenthesis correspond with the map.

### **Thursday, May 23: Hidden Gems \* of Callaway**

7:00am

Art House open for registration. Coffee and snack provided.

10:00am–12:00pm

- Free painting demo by Jane Mudd – Prairie Fork Conservation Area (2). Please arrive early.

Lunch Suggestion

- Marlene's Restaurant (3) in Williamsburg, next to Crane's Country Store

Afternoon painting suggestions:

- Stay at Prairie Fork Conservation Area (2) – ponds, native prairies, rustic elements
- Calwood (7) – large granaries; farmsteads; stop inside Wright Brothers Store for parking instructions and suggested set-up locations.
- Tony Ferrugia Farm (8) – south of Calwood 2.8 miles (see map), Leisure Lake access
- Mudd Farms (27) – Creek bottom, bluff, trees, old barn

### **Friday, May 24: Highway 94**

8:00am

Art House open for registration and painting check-in. Coffee and snack provided.

Morning painting suggestions:

- Miscellaneous locations between Portland and Tebbetts (44) – rivers, flooded fields and farmsteads.
- Plummer property (12) in Portland – private residence with blufftop views of Missouri River
- Portland (13) and Mokane (14) River Accesses, along Highway 94
- Susie Ferguson Farm (17) in Tebbetts – Farm buildings, animals, rustic elements

Lunch suggestion:

- Holzhauser's Grill (15) in Portland or Mokane Bar & Grill

Afternoon painting suggestions:

- Continue exploring Highway 94 (44) locations
- Garriott Farm (9) off of Mokane Rd.
- Prairie Garden Trust (4), New Bloomfield

- Artist Meet & Greet Cocktail Hour and light dinner at Art House (bring in completed paintings)

## **Saturday, May 25: Paint the Town\* and Sunset\***

8:00am

Art House open for registration and painting check-in. Coffee and snack provided.

Morning painting suggestions:

- Brick District (21) – Historical downtown buildings, farmers market (9:00-12:00), surrounding historic neighborhoods including Westminster College (34)

Lunch Suggestion:

- Brick District eateries (see FAQ or visitor guide for list)

Afternoon painting suggestions:

- Stay in the Brick District, explore historic neighborhoods (22, 23, 24)
- Stinson Creek Trail (25), see separate trail map

Also nearby:

- Pierce Residence (19), Barnes Residence (20).
- Ousley Farm (10) – Lake
- Ann Wakeman's Rockpost Gardens (5) – native prairie

5:00–9:00pm

PAINTINGS DUE AT ART HOUSE. Paintings must be wired and ready to hang by 2:00. Artists can submit up to three pieces for judging. If space permits, additional works may be submitted for display.

- Artists may go to the Barnyard Smokehouse (Central Missouri Meat and Sausage) – just south of Fulton on Hwy 54 – indoor and outdoor seating; or Post Office Bar & Grill in the Brick District.

Exhibit opens to the public. Wet Paint Reception with live music by Bitter Root, food spread, cash bar
